

Declaration on due diligence for responsible supply chains of minerals from conflict-affected areas

PULSAR K. BOGUSZ SP. J. is committed to implementing a policy of responsible obtaining of minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas (OECD guidelines). It is our duty to respect human rights, therefore we undertake to refrain from any activities that contribute to financing conflicts and to comply with UN resolutions imposing sanctions or national laws implementing such resolutions.

To support this policy, our suppliers are committed to supplying 'DRC conflict-free' materials (the countries - Democratic Republic of Congo, Republic of Congo, Central African Republic, South Sudan, Zambia, Angola, Tanzania, Burundi, Rwanda and Uganda).

The materials/products supplied by our suppliers:

1. Do not contain tantalum, tin, tungsten, nor gold (3TG), or
2. If they do contain these minerals, they must be sourced outside the DRC and/or recycled sources or supplied only from smelters that have been approved by an independent party as conflict free.

We expect our suppliers to adopt policies and establish a due diligence programme to ensure compliance with the requirements of Regulation 2017/821.

If we discover that our supplier's efforts to comply with the regulation are not in line with the above, we reserve the right to take appropriate action, including termination of purchases from the supplier.
