RACK 19" cabinets enable integrating CCTV, AC, I&HAS, RTV, LAN, or other systems in small companies or households. They are intended for devices manufactured in enclosures of 19" standard. Thanks to RACK cabinets, devices are aesthetically mounted and protected against mechanical damage.





RACK cabinets assembly:


Insert the rear panel and two structural profiles into the lying bottom panel.

Then, add the top panel and screw the cabinet together from the left and right sides with 8 screws.




Place the cabinet so that you have access to its rear part. Screw the rear part with 4 screws. Lay the cabinet on its back to have access to the front part.

Screw the front part with 8 screws (two screws for each corner).




Lay the cabinet on its side and mount the RACK profiles with 4 screws (repeat the same process by laying the cabinet on the other side).




Caution

the distance of the RACK profiles can be adjusted stepwise forward and backward, according to the diagram below.





Set the RACK cabinet upright and install the side and front doors.














Mounting the RACK Cabinet:
